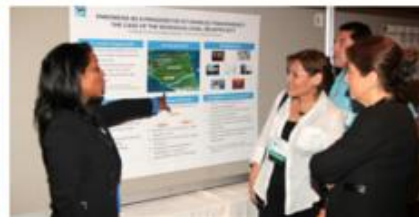

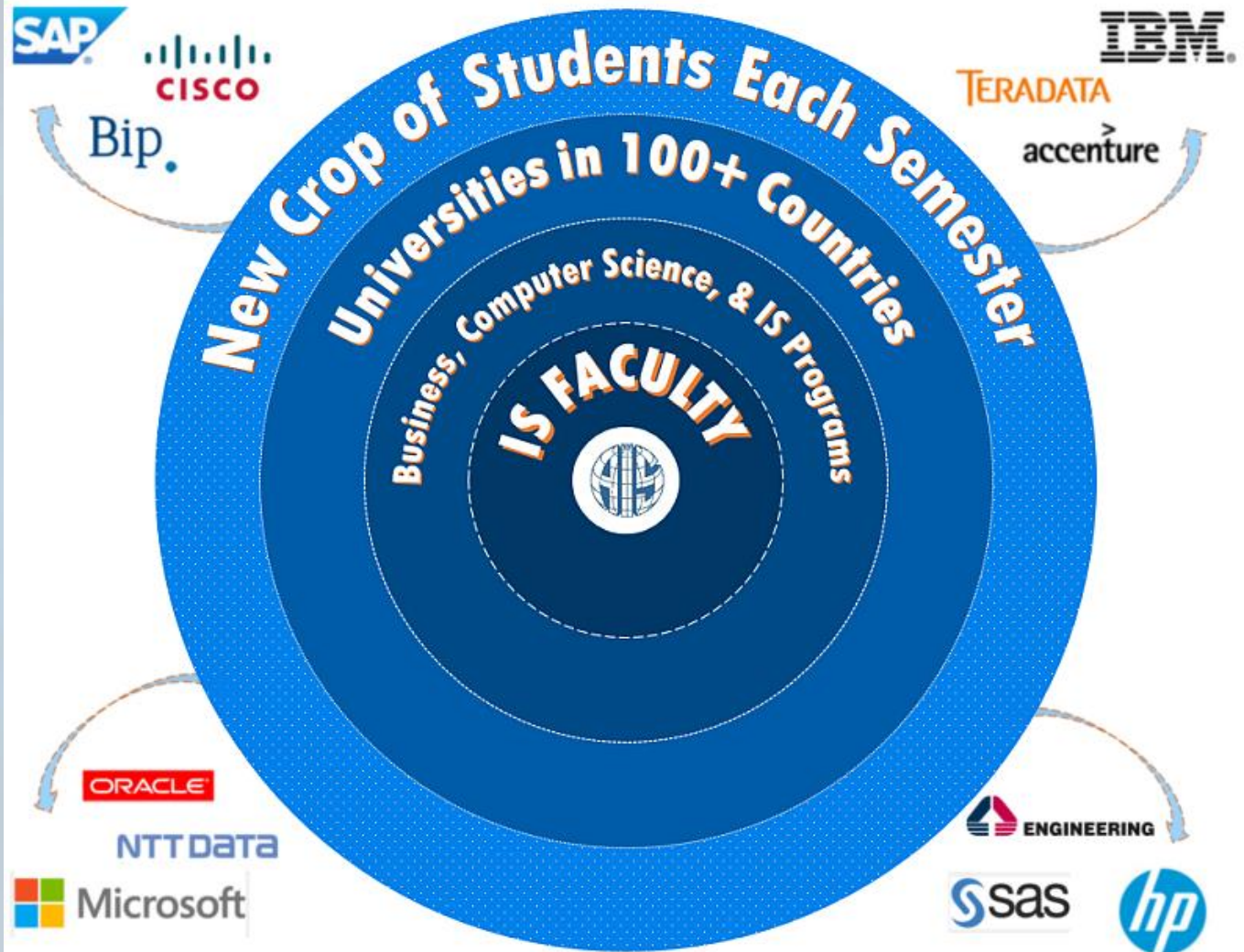
The Association for Information Systems serves society through the advancement of knowledge & the promotion of excellence in the practice and study of information systems.

- **Cultivate a community by providing services and products to meet the diverse needs of members and related communities.**

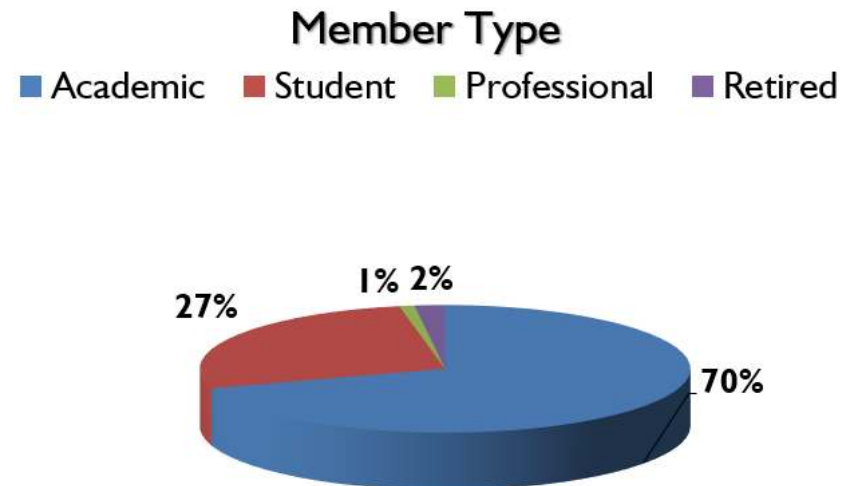

AIS Member Countries

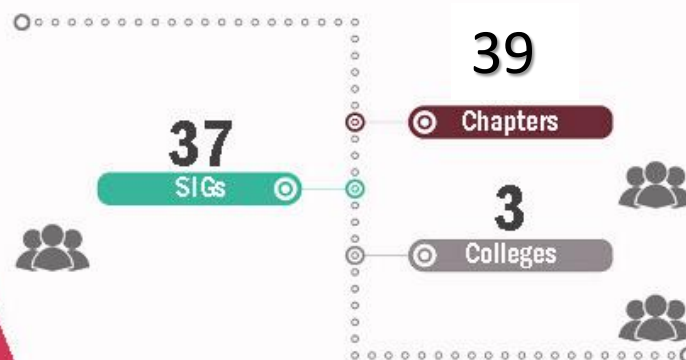

Chapters, SIGs, & Colleges

- **Special Interest Groups (SIGs)**
AIS Special Interest Groups (SIGs) allow those interested in a particular field of specialization to further connect with one another and exchange ideas and information. SIGs are organized around research topics.
- **Chapters**
AIS chapters allow information systems professionals and students who live in a particular region or country to come together and share knowledge and best practices.
- **Colleges**

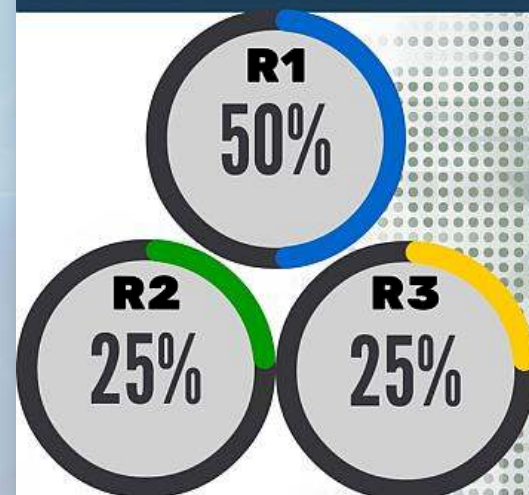


REGION 1:

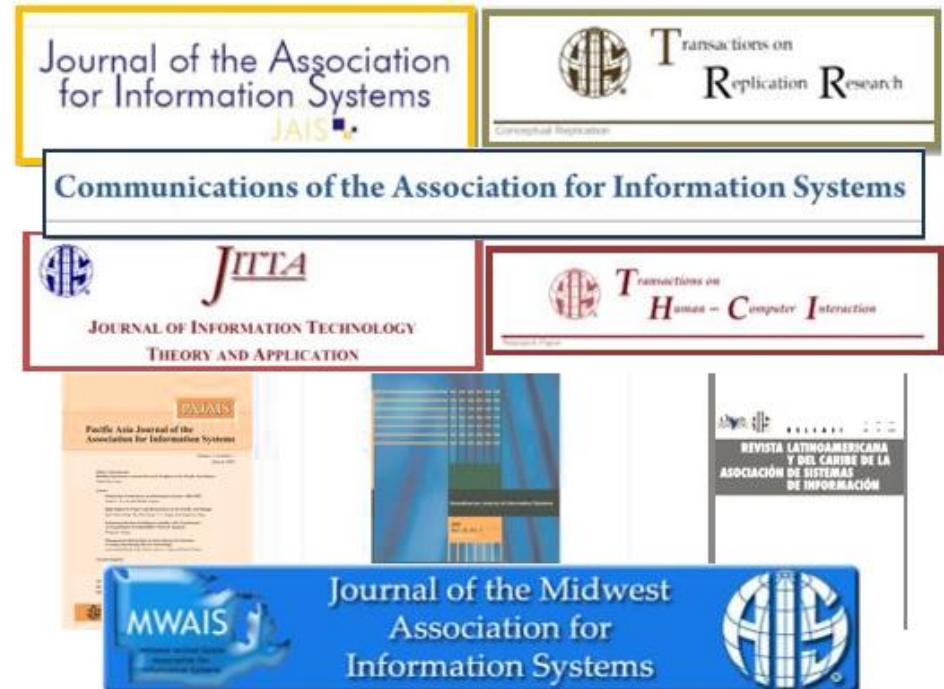


History

- ④ **1980 – Inaugurate the International Conference on Information Systems (ICIS).**
- ④ **1990 – First conference held outside U.S. (Copenhagen, Denmark).**
- ④ **1994 - The Association for Information Systems (AIS) is incorporated as a 501(c)6 trade association.**
- ④ **1995 – AIS inaugurated Americas Conference on Information Systems (AMCIS)**
- ④ **1995 – Inaugurated Pacific Asia Conference on IS**
- ④ **2002 - AIS and ICIS merge to form one organization, a 501(c)3 non-profit corporation**
- ④ **2015 – PACIS merged as AIS Region 3 Conference**
